**FCPM 235: Introduction to Residential Property Management** (3) An introduction to professional practices in residential property management. **FCPM 275:** Marketing and Leasing Residential Properties (3) Attracting and retaining qualified residents is the foundation of the multi-family housing industry. The course includes a lab with experiences in property maintenance. Course Prerequisite: FCPM 235
