New Online Courses Have Career Focus

Ball State University's dual credit courses prepare high school students for the rigors of a college curriculum. Now, we are introducing students to career possibilities in the growth industry of residential property management (RPM).

As you probably know, dual credit courses meet both high school and college requirements *and* give students a head start on their academic record. Since our RPM program offers four 3-credit-hour classes fully online, freshmen can arrive on campus with 12 credit hours on their transcripts that can count toward an RPM major or minor *and* the confidence to perform successfully in a university environment.

Why Ball State's RPM Program?

Ball State is the ideal university to offer dual credit in residential property management to your students because:

- Scholarships available
- One of nine universities in the nation to offer RPM
- Program includes online minor, major, master's degree option in RPM, plus online undergraduate apartment management certificate
- Online asynchronous classes mean students do not log in at fixed times but only for deadlines and class discussion
- Opportunities for on-site job shadowing and internships, and online chats with RPM professionals

- FCPM 275** Marketing and Leasing Residential Properties: Course prerequisites FCPM 104 and 235
- FCPM 305** Maintenance for Property Managers: Course prerequisite FCPM 235

Courses earned through dual credit will transfer as electives to most colleges and universities in Indiana.
